

Our orchestra Carowinds trip is this Saturday, May 20th. We will meet at Northwood in the cafeteria where I can take attendance and give instructions at 7:30am. The bus will leave by 8am and head to Carowinds theme park. Make sure everyone has had a good breakfast before you arrive since we will not be stopping for food. Everyone needs to bring money for food and remember that food is expensive in the park so plan accordingly. Student groups will have an assigned chaperone to be with them throughout the day and students must stay with their group.

We will all meet at the front gate inside the Carowinds park at 5:15pm and the bus will leave at 5:30pm. Make sure everyone saves time for dinner in the park before you get on the bus (we will not be stopping for food on the way back). I would plan on bringing a book bag to keep all of your items (snacks in sealable containers, cell phones, etc.) and leave it on the bus while you are in the park since the bus will be locked up during our time in the park. There will be no food brought out of the park on the bus. Drinks must have sealable lids as well. We do not want to have any spills on the bus. Will arrive back at school at 7:30pm.
